I. PURPOSE:

To establish nominations and elections processes for the Trauma Nurse Managers Association of California (TMAC) Board of Directors (BOD) positions in accordance with TMAC Bylaws.

II. POLICY / GUIDELINE:

A. Nominations Committee Chair/Members

- 1. The Nominations Committee will consist of three TMAC members and the Nominations Committee Chair, for a total of four members.
- The TMAC Directors at Large will serve as co-chairs of the Nominations Committee for a two (2) year term unless otherwise directed by the TMAC BOD President.
- 3. The co-chairs will be responsible for soliciting volunteers and appointing members of the Nominations Committee.

B. Candidate Eligibility

- Candidates eligible for a BOD position will be current TMAC members in good standing in the organization.
- The Nominations Committee co-chairs will review BOD roles and responsibilities with the candidates prior to formalizing the slate of nominees.



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- C. Call for Nominations and Voting
 - Call for nominations will be via email and TMAC website and listserv.
 - 2. A candidate's biography will be posted on the TMAC website during time of voting.
 - 3. Voting will be conducted electronically via email or an online survey course.
 - TMAC Members will be sent voting instructions by email and listserv. A reminder to vote will be sent after voting has been opened.

III. PROCEDURE:

- A. Nomination Committee Timeline:
 - 1. Midyear meeting
 - a. TMAC members will be advised of BOD positions that will be open for elections for the following year. Members interested in serving on the Committee will email a co-chair.
 - b. Co-chairs of Nominations Committee will announce the formation of the new Nominations Committee.
 - 2. October meeting
 - a. The co-chairs of the Nominations Committee will announce the membership of the new Committee.
 - 3. No later than October 31
 - a. The slate of nominees for BOD positions will be sent to the BOD for approval.



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- 4. No later than November 15
 - a. Approved nominees' biographies will be posted on the TMAC website and sent to the membership via the listserv.
 - b. Voting is open.
- 5. No later than November 30
 - Voting is closed.
- 6. No later than December 15
 - The current TMAC president will notify nominees of the outcome of the vote.
 - After all nominees are notified, the TMAC president will announce the outcome of the vote to the membership via website and listserv.
